23.68	Footpaths – to receive and if necessary act on information concerning the management and access allowed on footpaths within the parish, including those between Loqwfield Lane and Blue Bell Wood (discussed at November's meeting), between Lowfielsd Lane and the river via an abandoned farm building, and from St John's Churchyard to the trig point to the north of Dishforth Road.
